- **Kodaly Sampler or Level I Certification** - BYC incorporates a Kodaly-based musicianship philosophy. All sight-reading and music-learning is based on this philosophy.
- **Knowledge of Folk Repertoire** - As a Kodaly-based program, we incorporate folk music from around the world in our repertoire. Creative performance practices, including Curwen hand signs, dance, and play songs, are important to our curriculum.
